Students will have the opportunity to explore a variety of emotions, ensemble team-work, and story-telling while building relationships with peers through dramatic play. Classes will meet once a week for 6 weeks and are 60 minutes long.

Each class will be designed to meet the needs of students with various challenges such as Autism Spectrum Disorder, Down Syndrome, or other social challenges. Activities are best suited to students who are verbal and interacting socially. Enrollment is not restricted to students with a diagnosis. Siblings and friends are welcome & encouraged to participate.

Classes will be formed for different age-levels (elementary through young adults) Tuesdays or Thursdays at 10:30-11:30 and 12:30-1:30 with a performance date to be announced. Please call to register & discuss class options. Classroom space has been donated at the First Presbyterian Church.
